After lunch we are off to **The Ohio State Reformatory**, to experience firsthand the history and legacy of the Ohio State Reformatory, a building with countless stories that range from terrifying and tragic to inspiring and hopeful. Step through the silver screen and into the prison where Andy and Red struck up a friendship for the ages in 1994's **The Shawshank Redemption**.
