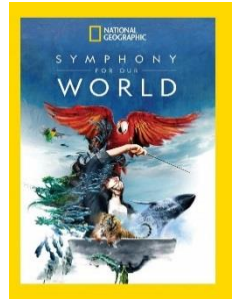
#### **SYMPHONY FOR OUR WORLD**

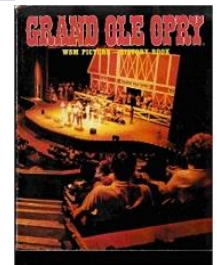

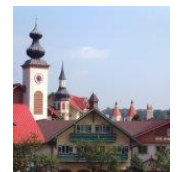
## JUNE

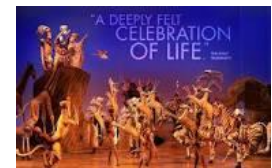

## HOW OUR TRIPS WORK

- Everyone is welcome, non-YMCA members slightly higher
- Each trip requires a deposit (non-refundable) due upon registration. Registration/payments can be done over the phone using your credit card or in person at any Greater Cleveland YMCA
- Trips have both a minimum and maximum number of occupants. To ensure your seat, register early. There may be instances where a trip might be cancelled or rescheduled, if this happens *full* refunds (including the deposit) are given
- When you register for a trip and it is full, ask to be put on the "Waiting List". Quite often, life happens and people have to cancel and we turn to the waiting list.
- Cancellation policy: Full refunds will be given (minus the deposit) up to "FINAL PAYMENT/BALANCE DUE DATE" After balance due date no refunds are available, trips are transferable, or can be sold to another traveler. If your trip cannot be transferred/resold, your trip amount (minus deposit) may be applied to another trip in the same year.
